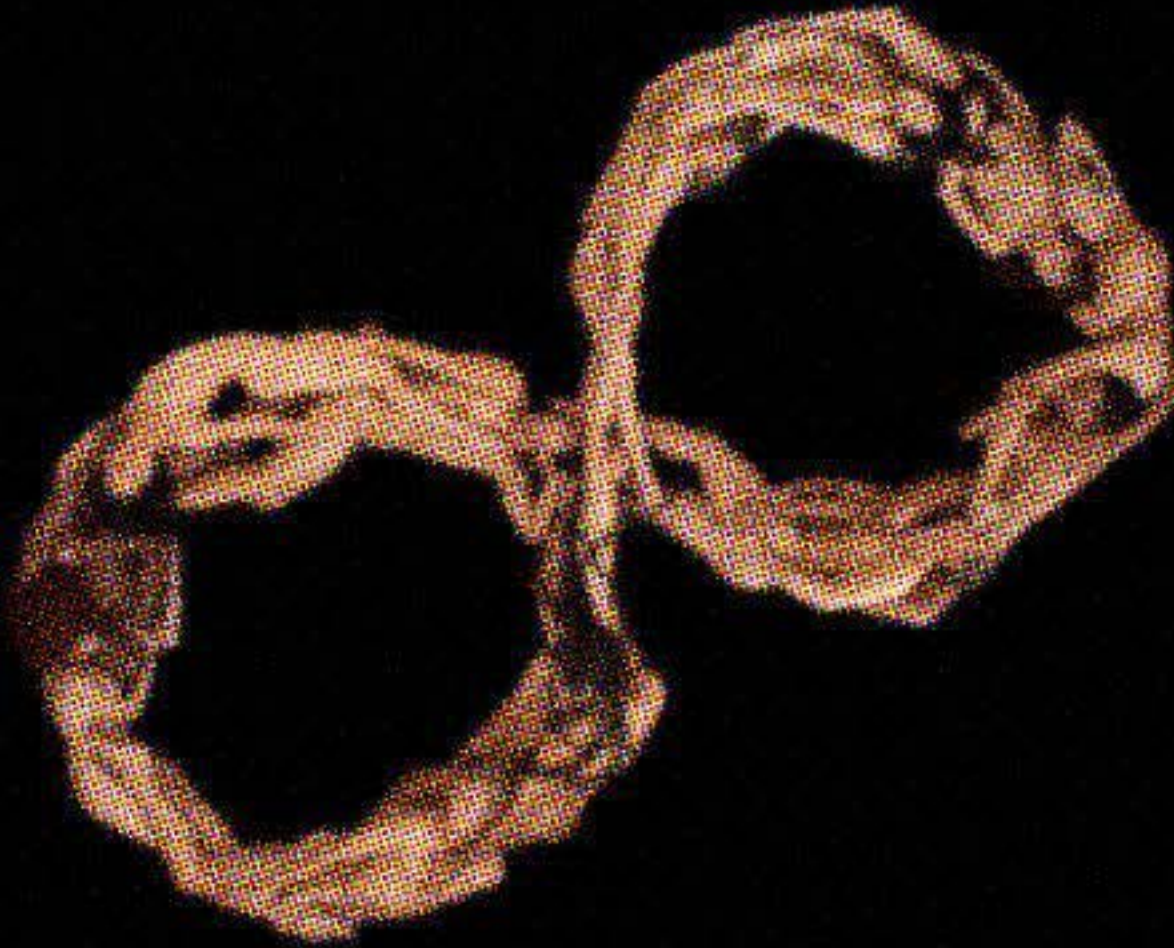


How To Have

Kant was correct that sexual relations are inherently morally problematic, though not for the reasons that he himself identified. Human sexual activity is fraught with moral danger because humans imbue sexual activity with a multitude of different meanings and intentions that are not always transparent to the participants. This fact raises particular challenges for the practice of giving and obtaining proper consent – a practice that often, though not always, has the normative power to transform impermissible behavior into permissible behavior. Yet it is possible to overcome these challenges.
